Sept. 29, 1771, Daniel Alvord and his wife Phebe renewed their covenant in the First Church in Middletown, Conn. Land records at Middletown show that the family resided on west side of river and that Daniel Alvord owned land in "Newfield" and "Westfield" which he transferred in 1781, 1788-9 and 1794. He and his wife removed, probably with his son, Butler Alvord, to Fondasbush, now Broadalbin, N. Y., in 1804 or 1805. He lived with this son and accompanied him on his removal to Amsterdam, N. Y., where both father and son died within a few months of each other, Mrs. Alvord then went to live with her son Elijah at Mayfield, N. Y., where she died.

Rev. War Service: "Alvord, Daniel, Private, Capt. Butler's Co. of Maj. Sheldon's Reg. of Light Horse, Marched Oct. 25, 1776; dis. Nov. 13, 1776. This command in whole or in part accompanied Washington on his retreat through N. J. in Dec. 1776." (Conn. Men in the Rev.)
