Martin Alvord was a farmer at Bolton, Conn., living about one mile south from the center of the town on the main road. Joseph Clark, the father of his second wife, graduated at Dartmouth College in 1785. He had previously served in the Revolutionary War. After the battle of Lexington he walked from Columbia, Conn., to Boston, fought in the battle of Bunker Hill and then went to Long Island, where he was taken prisoner and put on the Mill Prison Ship. The ship was so crowded with prisoners that they could neither lie down nor scarcely stand. In this condition they were kept for two days and when taken on deck, many of them took cold and died. Joseph Clark was then carried to Halifax and thence to England, where he remained a prisoner for more than two years. On being exchanged he joined the army of Gen. Sullivan. After the Wyoming Masacre he marched up the Genesee Valley. When peace was declared he studied law with Gen. Sullivan of Kittery, Me., and began to practice in Rochester, N. H. At one time he was candidate for Governor of N. H. Several of his addresses were published.
