Charles Elbridge Alvord went to Cal. in 1852 with Ben Halliday and engaged in mining in Plumas and Lassen Cos. Later he moved to Santa Barbara and worked at the trade of harness and saddle making which he had learned of his father. He also served as judge at Santa Barbara for several years.
