

dry goods store and ashery, also acting as postmaster and treasurer of the township. In the year 1866 he removed to Mich. and taught the schools of Camden that winter, and the next spring he was elected township clerk and assisted his brother, N. A. Alvord, in the dry goods store. In 1867 he went to Ames, Story Co., Iowa. Held the office of city clerk, and was connected with a real estate agency. Mr. Alvord returned to Ohio in 1870 and purchased one hundred acres of the old homestead. In the spring of 1881, with the advent of the Wabash Ry., he purchased an additional farm and laid out the town of Alvordton. The town is in a very prosperous condition and H. D. Alvord, in whose honor the town was named, has done more for its advancement than any other man. He has erected there one of the finest stone and brick hotels in that section. Mr. Alvord is noted for his enterprise and energy. He is a Republican in politics and has held many public offices, having been justice of the peace from 1873-79, and notary public since 1879.
