In Dec. 1854 Charles Nelson Alvord and wife went to Kalamazoo Co., Mich., and lived there nine years, after which he moved to Newaygo and from there to Ashland, where he lived twenty-five years. He was a thriving business man, a carpenter and joiner by trade, but followed various other occupations, such as lumbering, and running sawmills. He was regarded as one of the best farmers in that section. His home was one of the finest and was kept in the best order. His education was nearly all acquired after his marriage, being taught by his wife. He died of heart failure.
