


FAMILY OF THOMAS RHODES.

17. **THOMAS RHODES,**⁴ John,³ William,² Thomas,¹ was born at Pumpkin Hook, Ash Grove, Washington County, N. Y. Student at Cazenovia Seminary, 1828. He bought, 1830, half interest in woolen mill at Pulaski, N. Y., but soon traded same

for half interest in woolen mill at Marcellus Falls, N. Y. April 17, 1831, he married Emily Shepard. In 1834 sold out to his brother Robert, and bought farm 131 acres near Marcellus Falls. In 1836 sold and bought 139 acre farm at Jordan, his home for twenty-eight years, until 1864, when he sold the 206 acres for \$20,600, and bought 200 acres at Fairmount, N. Y., at \$69 per acre. Sold same, 1865, at \$100 per acre, and
