"June 7, 1745, Noah Alvord of Springfield, in the county of Hampshire, blacksmith, for six pounds," conveyed, "to my brother, Joseph Alvord of Northampton, all the lands which I have in Northampton, whether divided or undivided; as I am an heir to my Honrd father, Mr. Ebenezer Alvord, late of Northampton, deces-d; as also I am an heir to the estate of my grandfather, Mr. Joseph Baker formerly of Northampton, deces-d, both by my Hon^d mother who was the daughter to sd Joseph Baker, and also by my brother Ebenezer Alvord dec-d an heir to the sd Ruth my Honoured mother and grandmother aforesaid.

He was born Northampton, Mass., Aug., 1716; died Northampton, Mass., Jan. 7, 1802. Res. Northampton, Mass. Children:
