Seth Alvord joined the church in Middletown, Jan. 20, 1734, and later settled in North Guilford, Conn., where he lived until 1748, when he moved to East Hampton. The house built and occupied by Seth Alvord is still standing; built about 1748. It is in a good state of repair and stands a little east of the Cong. Church. His occupation is not definitely known but probably he was a farmer. The text of his funeral sermon was: Gen. 35,29. "And Isaac gave up the ghost."

Miss Lucy Alvord of Winsted, Conn., has in her possession a book upon which is written "Elizabeth Spencer, her book, July 15, A. D., 1737." She was then twenty years of age and not yet married. This book she gave to her son Reuel on his departure for his first voyage at sea.

May 15, 1760, Seth Alvord was chosen quorister in the East Hampton Church.

56. ELISHA ALVORD (*Thomas, Thomas, Alexander*), born Northampton, Mass., June 19, 1717; died Fairfield, Conn., Jan. 28, 1776; married 1st, Abigail. She died Durham, Conn., Nov. 15, 1743, in her 25th year. He married 2nd, Fairfield, Conn., May 9, 1745, Hannah Goodsell, daughter of Rev. John and Mary (Lewis) Goodsell. She was born Fairfield, Conn., Aug. 9, 1726; died Fairfield, Conn., May 20, 1757. He married 3rd, Fairfield, Conn., Mary. Res. Greenfield Hill Parish, Fairfield, Conn. Children:
