In June, 1811, Peter B. Beals and nephew, Ebenezer Ford, arrived at Troy, O., and selected lot No. 1. He built the second cabin in the township, then returned in the fall to Mass. In June, 1812, with wife and five children and with other settlers he returned to Troy. The migration was made in five wagons, three drawn by oxen, two by horses. In the fall of 1812 Mr. Beals built the first frame barn in the place, soon after this he was taken sick and was left a cripple for life. For this reason he bought a tavern in Burton, O. He was postmaster there for 25 years. In his later life he met with heavy financial losses.

95. RHODA ALVORD (*Ebenezer, Ebenezer, Alexander*), bapt. Northampton, Mass., July 14, 1771; married Mr. Warren. Res. in Ohio. (No further record.)

ZEBADIAH ALVORD (*John, Jonathan, Alexander*), born Northampton, Mass., Feb. 14, 1724; died Easthampton, Mass., Feb. 16, 1806; married Northampton, Mass., May, 1750, Rebecca Searl, daughter of Elisha and Rebecca (Danks) Searl. She was born Northampton, Mass., Dec. 19, 1728; died Easthampton, Mass., July 18, 1804. Res. Northampton, Mass., and Easthampton, Mass. Children:
