

153. AZARIAH ALVORD (*John, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born prob. South Hadley, Mass., Jan. 20, 1738; died South Hadley, Mass., Jan. 11, 1819; married 1st, Springfield, Mass., Jan. 5, 1762, Abigail Nash, daughter of Daniel and Abigail Nash. She was born South Hadley, Mass., Feb. 17, 1740; died South Hadley, Mass., Mar. 31, 1782. He married 2nd, Mar. 5, 1789, Lucy Nash, daughter of Eleazer and Phebe (Kellogg) Nash. She was born Granby, Mass., Sept. 18, 1750; died Dec. 24, 1836. Res. Springfield, West Springfield, Mass., and South Hadley, Mass. Children:

May 3, 1763, Azariah Alvord of Springfield, Mass., purchased of his uncle, Lieut. Job Alvord, one mansion house, barn, and four acres of land at a place called "Willamanseep" in Springfield, Mass.

June 9, 1768, Azariah Alvord of Springfield, Mass., conveyed land in South Hadley, Mass., to his father, Daniel Nash, of South Hadley.

In later years Azariah Alvord bore the title of Capt. He was one of those from South Hadley who accompanied the expedition to Canada in 1760 at the close of the French and Indian War.

Rev. War Service: "Alvord, Azariah, 1st Lieut., Capt. James (also given Moses) Montague, 2nd Co. Col. Porter's 4th Hampshire Co. Reg. List of officers of Mass. Militia commissioned May 28, 1778. Also Capt. Job Alvord's Co. Col. S. Murray's Hampshire Co. Reg. Enlisted July 4, 1780; dis. Oct. 10, 1780; service 3 mos, 15 days. Company raised to re-enforce Continental Army." (Mass. Soldiers in Rev.)

LUTHER ALVORD (*John, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born South Hadley, Mass., Mar. 4, 1753; died South Hadley, Mass., 1784; married Elizabeth Ingram, perhaps daughter of Nathaniel and Martha (Kellogg) Ingram. She was born 1752; died South Hadley, Mass., Dec., 1839. Res. South Hadley, Mass. Children:
