She was born Middletown, Conn., Nov. 15, 1782; died Hartford, Conn., Jan. 19, 1873. He married 2nd, Middletown, Conn., Nov. 14, 1822, Sophia Pease, perhaps daughter of Peter and Anne (Bliss) Pease, who was born Glastonbury, Conn., Mar. 9, 1805. Res.
