

443. TILTON EASTMAN ALVORD (*Enos, Gad, John, Thomas, Alexander*), bapt. Wilmington, Vt., Aug. 24, 1796; died Canton, Conn., Nov. 2, 1872; married Julia Chapman, daughter of Caleb Chapman. She was born Montgomery, Mass., 1825; died Norwich, Conn., Jan. 20, 1891. Res. Canton, Conn., New Hartford, Conn., and Hartford, Conn. Child:

Tilton Eastman Alvord resided in Canton, Conn., at two different periods, also in New Hartford, Conn., and Hartford, Conn. He became paralytic and received aid from the town about 1865. At one time he was in the employ of Rider and Alden, brokers.

445. ENOS ALVORD (*Enos, Gad, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born 1802; died New York, N. Y.; buried in Torrington, Conn.; married Norah (or Honora) Hills. She died New Rochelle, N. Y., 1855. Res. New Rochelle, N. Y., and New York City. (Office in 1868 was 37 Park Row, Room No. 52.) No children.

After the death of his wife Enos Alvord went to New York City and was in an advertising agency.

446. NELSON ALVORD (*Enos, Gad, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born Westfield, Mass., 1805; died Torrington, Conn., Nov. 2, 1879; married 1st, Lavinia Flower of Barkhamsted, Conn. He married 2nd, Millerton, N. Y., Apr., 1873, Harriett Electa (Taylor) Woodruff, widow of Henry M. Woodruff, daughter of John and Fanny (String) Taylor. She was born Torrington, Conn., Feb. 14, 1829. Res. Wolcottville, Torrington, Conn. No children.

Nelson Alvord was a harness maker by occupation.

448. CLARISSA ALVORD (*Justin, Job, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born South Hadley, Mass., Nov. 15, 1797; died Rochester, N. Y., June 20, 1882; married South Hadley, Mass., Oct. 30, 1818, Porter Taylor, son of Oliver and Luey (White) Taylor. He was born South Hadley, Mass., Dec. 16, 1794; died Rochester, N. Y., July 20, 1872. Res. Rochester, N. Y. Children:
