521. WILLIAM ALVORD (*William, Elisha, Joseph, Ebenezer, Alexander*), born Rutland, Vt., Feb. 25, 1801; died Savannah, Ga., Dec. 17, 1837; married Albany, N. Y., Jan. 9, 1826 Mary Elizabeth Whitney, daughter of Selleck and Betsey (Knapp) Whitney. She was born Stamford, Conn., Nov. 14, 1806; died San Francisco, Cal., Feb. 3, 1870. Res. Albany, N. William Alvord died at Savannah, Ga. while on a visit there for his health. His death was premature and cut short a career of high promise. But short as it was, it was signalized by the exhibition of many generous and attractive qualities of head and heart which endeared him to a large circle of admiring friends. He was an importer of foreign goods, and a manufacturer of furniture; in partnership with John Meads.

After her husband's death the widow of William Alvord resided with her son William in San Francisco, Cal.
