He served during the entire Civil War, and left the service with a captain's commission. Previous to the war he showed that he had remarkable natural talent as an artist, and produced numerous paintings. He settled in Hillsdale and engaged in mercantile pursuits. He was a Free-Mason and Knight Templar, having received the degree of Knighthood in Columbia Commandery, No. 2, Washington, D. C.
