Y., July 1, 1832; died Appleton, Minn., May 9, 1907; married Avon, Lake Co., Ill., Dec. 3, 1863, Mary Lovey Ogston, daughter of Alexander and Isabella (Scott) Ogston. She was born Scotland, May 13, 1840. Res. Appleton, Minn. Children:

'Onias Alvord went with his parents to Lake Co., Ill., in 1839. He was a soldier in the Civil War, serving nine months in Co. E, 48th Ill. Reg. He enlisted Nov. 17, 1864, was mustered out Aug. 15, 1865. He was in the battle of Nashville and several other lesser engagements. In Sept., 1879, he removed from Newport, Ill., to Appleton, Minn., and bought half interest in a flour and feed mill in which business he continued until his death.
