

1682. LUCY VELONA ALVORD (*Sylvester, Ebenezer, Thomas Gould, Asahel, Thomas, Thomas, Alexander*), born Homer, N. Y., Mar. 24, 1827; died Homer, N. Y., Oct. 7, 1847; married Homer, N. Y., July 30, 1846, William Dalrymple. He died New York, N. Y. Res. Homer, N. Y. No children.

William Dalrymple was a dentist in Homer, N. Y. Later he removed to New York City. He was a man of dissipated habits. He married a second time and had two children, one of whom still lives in New York City.

In Nov. 1853 Thomas Moody Alvord in company with his brother Henry, Alonzo Lewis and J. B. Crooker, left N. Y. State for Cal. They put in a garden on the Calaveris River in 1854. In July it was destroyed by grasshoppers. Mr. Alvord then went to the mines and remained there until June, 1858, with the exception of one summer when he engaged in logging. At the time of the gold excitement in British Columbia, he went up the Frazier River. Being unsuccessful he located on the White River at Pialschie in Feb. 1859 and engaged in farming on a very large scale, owning a farm of 1,000 acres. Since 1886 he has been most especially engaged in dairy farming.
