E. H. Talcott worked on his father's farm in New York State until he was twenty-one years old. His father dying at this time he went to Talcottville, Conn., where he became superintendent in the woolen mill of Talcott Bros. Later he was in charge of their general store and the post office, in which position he continued until 1878. During the four years following, Mr. Talcott was a commercial traveler, with his residence at Bolton, Conn. In 1882 he moved to Torrington, Conn., where he bought a grain and feed store, which he conducted successfully until his death. Mr. Talcott's first wife was Sarah Adell Linkletter, by whom he had one son, Dennison L., b. Sept. 2, 1870.
