James Church Alvord graduated at Williston Seminary, Easthampton, Mass., in 1881, from Williams College in 1885 and from Andover Theological Seminary in 1888. He was called to Hamilton, Mass., in June, 1888, and was ordained to the Congregational ministry Sept. 9, 1888 by the Essex South Association and Conference. After a pastorate of five years at Hamilton, he became pastor of the Globe Cong. Church at Woonsocket, R. I. Under Mr. Alvord's pastorate the church greatly prospered. Its membership doubled and a new church of brick and stone was erected. Mr. Alvord is now (1908) residing in Boston, preaching and doing literary work.

Mrs. Alvord's father is at the head of the Fairbanks' Scales Co. and son of the inventor of the scales, Thaddeus Fairbanks, who was knighted by the Emperor of Austria.
