


PEDIGREE OF GEOFFREY, OR JEFFREY, DUDLEY, OF RUSSELLS HALL, STAFFORDSHIRE, ENGLAND.

JEFFREY DUDLEY,* of Russells Hall, gent., m. at Tipton, Jan. 20, 1611, living 1641, = ELIZABETH DUDLEY, *alias* TOMLINSON; buried at Dudley, March 28, 1647, natural daughter of Edward, Lord Dudley.



* There was a Thomas Sutton, *alias* Dudley, of Netherton, who made his will Feb. 3, 1646-7, proved Aug., 1647, who seems to have been a brother to Jeffrey. He left a large estate and many descendants at Dudley and about that region.

† He died at Dudley, 1684.

‡ She married William Hand, of Dudley, cooper, and had children. He died 1721. She died 1725.

§ His real estate went to his five aunts or their representatives, who sold it. In 1738, William, Lord Dudley, and Ward purchased four or five undivided parts of the estate, and subsequently the other part. Russells Hall has long since been taken down.—*Staffordshire Collections, by Graybrook.*
