4 NATHANIEL JEWELL m. Mary, only daughter of Baptizo Smedley, of Concord, Mass., June 9, 1676; rd. in Concord until after the birth of his children.

In 1689 a number of families from Mass. purchased a tract of land in Connecticut, of the heirs of Gov. Winthrop; and Nathaniel, and his second wife, Margaret, were found there on the incorporation of the town in 1699, which the following year received the name of Plainfield. He seems to have been a prominent man in both civil and ecclesiastical affairs; was a blacksmith, which was an important consideration to the early colonists; had
