

13 Feb. 1570-1. John Bysse of Stoke St. Michael, co. Somerset. Wife Elizabeth—son John Bysse, the elder—son James Bysse—son George Bysse—son John Bysse, the younger—son Thomas—son Edward—daughter Aune Bysse, and her mother and brother James—said Anne had a legacy of £20 under the will of her uncle—daughter Grace, under 18 and unmarried—brother Richard Bysse—eldest son James Bysse, ex'or. Proved 6 April 1571. (14 Holney.)

30 June 1576. Adm'on to John Bisse, late of Marston Bigott, co. Somerset, dec'd, granted to Roger Bisse, the son.

19 May 1579. "I Lawrence Bisse of Shaston." To be buried in the church of St. Peter—wife Margery, ext'x. Proved 29 Jan. 1579-80. (8 Arundel.)

13 July 1582. Will of James Bisse. Wife—eldest son—two eldest brothers—son Thomas—"fare well good Megge" (testator's wife probably)—cousin John—son James—mother. Proved 16 May 1583 by etc. for Margaret, the relict and ext'x. (45 Rowe.) In the Probate Act book testator is described as of [blank] in the county and diocese of Bristol.

2 April 1585. "John Bysse of Pensford in the countie of Somersett." Brother Richard Bisse—brother William Baynard—brother Thomas Baynard—father-in-law Puttinge—mother—sister Margaret Bysse, ext'x. Proved 30 April 1589. (42 Leicester.)

28 Nov. 1591. Richard Bisse of Bristowe, merchant. To be buried in the church of St. Thomas—mother Margaret Gilbert—brother Laurence Bisse—sister Johane Phillippes—wife's two children Richard Bentall and Katherine Bentall—to the poor of Publoe, co. Somerset—wife Katherine—son John, under 21—brother William Bisse—father-in-law Harry Gilbert—father-in-law John Harte—Peter Bisse a witness. Proved 10 Dec. 1591 by etc. for Katherine, the relict, power reserved to John Bisse, the son. (93 Sainberbe.)

21 May 1593. John Bisse, the elder, of Paglinche, co. Somerset, gent. Wife living, but son John Bisse universal legatee and sole ex'or. Witnesses, James Bisse and John Gibbes "with others." Proved 27 Nov. 1593. (77 Neville.)

15 April 1597. Adm'on to Henry Bisse, late of Henstridge, co. Somerset, dec'd, granted to Hugh Bisse, the brother.

9 Nov. 1600. John Bisse of Corseley, co. Wilts, gent. Eldest son—two younger sons—daughter—wife Joan—children under age—kinsman Edward Bisse of Sprategrane, co. Somerset, gent., an ex'or—brother William Awbrey, gent., an overseer. Adm'on with the will 7 March 1600-1 to Johan Bisse, the relict, the ex'ors having renounced. (22 Woodhall.)

James Bysse of Croscombe, co. Somerset. Son James, the elder—son Robert—daughter Elizabeth—son James, the younger—daughter Joyce Penn—to "James
