

"Alvord, Elijah, Private, Capt. Benson's Co., Col. Putnam's Reg. Continental Army. Pay accounts for service from Apr. 24, 1780 to Oct. 24, 1780. Reported deserted Oct. 24, 1780." (Mass. Soldiers in Rev.)

Elijah Alvord applied for a pension May 2, 1818. His claim was allowed. In application it is stated that he was at Buygoyne's surrender.

John Alvord settled in Pascommuck (Easthampton) in 1751 or 1752. His name is on the Easthampton, Mass., tax list for 1784. He was assessed 1 poll, 1 house, 19½ acres of land. In 1748 John Alvord, Jr., was in service after the fall of Louisberg. It may refer to John No. 59. In 1790 (U. S. census) John Alvord was living in same house with Benjamin Strong in Easthampton.
