372. BEZALEEL ALVORD (*Asariah, John, John, Thomas, Alexander*), born Springfield, Mass., Nov. 19, 1762; died Geneseo, N. Y., Sept. 2, 1827; married Mary Goodman, daughter of Noah and Abial (Smith) Goodman. She was born prob. South Hadley, Mass.; died Lima, Ind., 1837. Res. South Hadley, Mass. Children:

Bezaleel Alvord was a farmer. He removed from Pittsfield, Mass., to Geneseo, N. Y. shortly before his death. His estate was settled in the Probate Court at Pittsfield, Mass., Ansel Dewey, administrator.

Bezaleel Alvord and wife were received to Lenox Church from So. Hadley, June 3, 1821 and were dismissed from the church in Lenox, Mass., Apr., 1825, to "any church." Also Aug. 3, 1837, Widow Mary Alvord to "any church." On the same date Ansel Dewey was dismissed.

Mrs. Mary (Goodman) Alvord went from Mass. with her daughter Philancy and husband in 1837 to Lima, Ind., in a lumber wagon, stopping there to visit her sons before going to the home of her daughter in Ill. She was taken sick and died in a few days.
