The greater part of William Harley Alvord's life was spent in the mercantile business in Brooklyn, N. Y., to which he was well adapted. In the early "fifties" he caught the craze for Pike's Peak, obtained an outfit and pressed on long after the trail was strewn with the carcasses of beasts that had fallen by the way. Meeting so many men returning discouraged he also turned back. Mrs. Alvord met her death by falling from a fourth-story window while hanging out clothes.
