



# DOWN AT THE SEASHORE



**PIPING ROCK MODEL HOUSE**

Built stronger than usual method of construction. Built of standard sections completed at factory—need only be bolted together at site. Painted three coats white on side walls. Oiled inside. Roof stained beautiful green. Blinds painted green. Benches included in price. Porch floors made of bricks laid flat on ground, not included in price. Will accept orders for 30-day delivery. Weight about 21,000 pounds. Terms—25% with order, balance on presentation of Bill of Lading.  
 Plan A—Eleven Hundred Dollars (\$1100), F. O. B. Brooklyn.  
 Plan B—Same type of house with second floor of two rooms upstairs—eighteen hundred and fifty Dollars—(\$1850).
