


# OUR ALLIES in their COMMON CAUSE


Camera shots here and there picturing incidents in the war activities of seven of the nations brought together by the war on the Hun.


Above—The King of Rumania directs his own troops. He is shown leaving his headquarters wearing a regulation steel helmet. Central News.
